There are many to see in the coastal area, where tourists surely can feel the unique atmosphere of the southern, coastal Taiwan. By refering to Michelin's recommendation, the Tainan City Government Tourism Bureau plans the 3-satr rated "Religious Tour of Fishing and Salt Industry around West Coast": Nankunshen Temple, Jingzaijiao Tile-paved Salt Fields, Donglong Temple, Cigu Salt Mountains, Taiwan Salt Museum, Cigu Lagoon, and Black-faced Spoonbill Conservation Area

Nankunshen Temple is rated 3-star by the internationally renowned the "Michelin Green Guide Taiwan." It is one of the most important temples in Taiwan and also the oldest Wangye Temple. Nankunshen Temple was built in 1662 and has gone through repair and expansion for many times. Not until 1928, the Temple becomes what it looks like today. The temple worships the Great King Li, the Second King Chi, the Third King Wu, the Fourth King Jhu, and the Fifth King Fan. The Temple has many branches around Taiwan. During the Wangye Sacrificial Rites, believers around Taiwan would swarm into the Nankunshen Temple. The scale of the parade formation held in the Temple's square with many psychics

The Nankunshen Cultural Museum is a dovetailed, three-story, teak building. The museum gives introduction to Nankunshen Temple, its history, the miracles performed by the Five Kings, and the life story of the artist, Hong, Tong. It is worth visiting.

Blackfoot Disease was a commonly seen disease in the west coastal area of Taiwan in early days. It was because the drinking water from wells was contaminated by arsenic. Taiwan Blackfoot Disease Socio-Medical Service Memorial House is the first medical memorial house in Taiwan. The Memorial House preserves the medical records written by Dr. Jin-He Wang, who helped the Blackfoot patient without charging fees from 1975.

井仔腳瓦盤鹽田 Jingzaijiao Tile-paved Salt Fields

With a history of 338 years, Jinzaijiao Tile-paved Salt Field is the oldest salt field in Taiwan. According to archives, in the Ming Dynasty, Yong-hua Chen, Koxinga's chief counselor, considered that the salt making techniques employed by the Pingpu Tribe was not good enough to produce good-quality salt. Chen therefore improved the old techniques. Chen had broken tiles paved on the salt fields. A kind of refined salt was thereby produced. The Salt Field currently is left in the charge of Southwest Coast National Scenic Area for industrial, cultural and educational uses. Tourists can try making salt on their own here.

There are four wharfs around the Cigu Lagoon. Visitors can take a ride on the raft, and leave for the sandbar "Wangziliaoshan." Over the Lagoon, visitors can see many various types of oyster cribwork and fishing nets, which are used to catch fishes (due to the different depth of the water) and the migrant bird, Cormorants.

七股潟湖 Cigu Lagoon

Cigu Lagoon, the largest lagoon in Taiwan, is comprised of "Dingtoueshan," "Wanziliaoshan," and "Cingshangangshan." Lagoon prevents flood, and offers protection to the coast, and gives rich marine biology. Cigu Lagoon has a large field of mangroves and provides migrant birds habitats. Fishermen also catch fishes and cultivate oysters here.



Wangye Cultural Gallery (beside Sanliaowan Donglong Temple) The design of Wangye Cultural Gallery adopts the traditional Min style. The three-story Temple sits on a land over 200 acres.

There are Shueihu Heroes Hall and Cultural Artifact Hall which

house 108 figures vividly made of koji pottery. The Gallery
